INTERNATIONAL EVENTS

TRAINERS CONFERENCE SAANSO (SOUTH ASIAN ASSOCIATION OF NATIONAL SCOUT ORGANIZATION) was established during the Chief Commissioner's Meeting of all the SAARC countries held on 13th October, 2008 at Bangladesh Jamuna Resort, Tangail, Una. The first Ever Trainers Conference successfully came to an end on 17th July 2022 with 24 participants (virtually and face to face) from Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan, and Sri Lanka at Hotel Goldi Sands in Negombo, Sri Lanka. A team of experienced Leader Trainers comprising of one course staff from SAANSO, three from ASARC, one from APR and one from Far East and the Course Director

was Mr. Janaprith Fernando, Chief Commissioner of Sri Lanka. The Secretary General of SAANSO Mr. Abdullah Rasheed was present at the conference. The aim of the conference is to establish a SAANSO Training Team to support national and sub regional level training programmes and strengthen the understanding of adults in scouting, adults resource management, develop trainers marketing skills etc.



The conference was inaugurated by the Additional Chief National Commissioner of BSG-India and Chief Advisor of SAANSO Mr. M. A. Khalid, (Retd. KAS) on 15th July, 2022.

Mr. Sumit Mukhopadhyay (West Bengal) was physically present while Mr. Kaushik Chatterjee (West Bengal) and Mr. Analendra Sarma (NHQ) were virtual participants. Four groups were formed - Charter House, Brown Sea, GilWell and Paddington. All the participants were fully occupied all the days from 15th to 17th July 2022 with input sessions by the experienced Trainers, Group Discussion and Presentation etc.

Topics like Aims and Objectives, Roles, Competencies and Responsibilities of the SAANSO Training Team Member, Challenges in implementation of quality training, Synergy of Training and Youth Programme, Strengthening the understanding of Adult Learning, Developing soft skills of Trainers,





Training Methods and Techniques beyond CALT (Cooperative learning, ICT etc.), Understanding Training traditions and practices and course standards, Trainers Market Skills specialization track for trainers, Trainers Market Skills specialization track for trainers etc. were discussed during the conference. The Closing ceremony of the conference was graced by the Regional Director World Scout Bureau Asia-Pacific Support Centre Mr. J. Rizal C. Mr. Syd Castilo, Director, Educational Methods, APR Support Centre has shared a real story about a poor child who became a successful citizen after joining scouting. Scouting is the way to Life. TRAINER'S CORNER

Scouts and Guides movement is based on its purpose, principles, values and the Method. These four pillars of the Movement give it a specific identity at local, state, national and international levels. Scout movement became popular all over the world within a very short time from the time it was founded because it has been identified as a movement for preparing youngsters to be good and efficient citizens. Scouting can succeed in fully achieving its educational purpose, only if its specific identity is protected.

If the movement is linked to any organisation or influenced by any other organisation or authority, it will have a negative impact on our movement because that organisation or authority may force us to change our ideals or purpose. So, our movement should have the capacity to take decisions freely by our own decision-making authority, without the interference of social, political or religious institutions. Our scout organisations at different levels may have partnership programmes with other institutions or organisations under the condition that educational purpose of scouting is not affected or influenced. It does not mean that our movement should operate in isolation. In fact, our movement has its specific identity and gain popularity at all levels due to the support of most of the institutions and other organisations.

At present, scouting movement is working on various global or national issues and is closely working with United Nations to achieve the SDGs. Let it be Plastic-tide-turner, child labour or issues related to girls, Scout Movement has been taking up such projects successfully in linking with other institutions or organisations. Whatever may be the issues, we work for them provided educational purpose of scouting is encouraged. At the same time, Scout Movement is highly cautious to protect our independence at different levels.

Members of our movement should be careful in protecting its self-identity and its common ethics. At all levels of the Movement, while we work with sponsoring bodies, working partners or similar organisations, governmental authorities, we are to be mindful in maintaining relationships with them, because we cannot compromise on our purpose, principles, values and the method.

Our movement at all levels may seek cooperation with other educational youth organisations, but such a cooperation must never lead to the loss or compromise of its own independence and specific







role in the education of young people. We may work with a religious or community organisations but such an organisation must never control our movement or it cannot treat our movement as a subordinate to it. In the same way, our links with local or national authorities must never affect our voluntary and non-formal educational role in society.

To conclude, on the nature of independence, all the members of the Scout Movement must note that the nature and specific identity of our Movement are internationally defined and agreed by all the National Scout Organisations.

Hints to our adult leaders:

- Work with other organisations or institutions following the procedure but they should not affect our purpose etc.
- Welcome sponsoring programmes but let them not misuse our Movement for their popularity.
- Choose the partnerships in such a way that such partnerships should not affect our fundamentals or educational purpose of the movement.
- It is everyone's responsibility to protect the self-identity and help to popularise our movement for the safety, welfare and leadership of future generation.

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS

SDG 1: NO POVERTY

THE CHALLENGE The world attained the first Millennium Development Goal target—to cut the 1990 poverty rate in half by 2015—five years ahead of schedule, in 2010. According to the World Bank, in 2015, one in ten people were living on less than USD 1.90 a day. Nearly 1.1 billion fewer people are living in extreme poverty than in 1990. In 2015, 736 million people lived on less than \$1.90 a day. The latest World Bank projections show that if we continue down a



business-as-usual path, the world will not be able to eradicate extreme poverty by 2030. Children, too, are victims of global poverty, with 29000 children dying every single day from preventable causes – such as diarrhoea, malaria, neonatal infection, pneumonia, preterm delivery, or lack of oxygen at birth – which are more often than not highly correlated with poverty.

WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT? Poverty is more than just the lack of income or access to resources – it manifests itself in diminished opportunities for education, social discrimination and the inability to participate in decision-making processes. For instance, in developing countries, children in the poorest households are four times less likely to be in school than those of the richest. But extreme deprivation is not just about wellbeing and opportunity; it is a question of survival itself. In Latin America and East Asia, the poorest children are three times more likely to die by age 5 than the richest.


HOW CAN WE ADDRESS THIS? Ending poverty in all its forms everywhere forms the first goal of the 2030 Sustainable Development agenda. It calls for ensuring social protection, enhancing access to basic services, and building resilience against the impacts of natural disasters which can cause severe damage to people's resources and livelihoods. The international community agrees, through the Sustainable Development agenda for 2030, that economic growth must be inclusive, especially of the most poor and vulnerable, and aims to eradicate extreme poverty for all people everywhere in the next 15 years.





INDIA AND GOAL 1

Global reduction in extreme poverty was driven mainly by Asia – notably China and India. Between 2005-06 and 2015-16, the incidence of multidimensional poverty in India was almost halved, climbing down to 27.5 percent from 54.7 percent as per the 2018 global Multidimensional Poverty Index report. Within ten years, the number of poor people in India fell by more than 271 million (from 635 million to 364 million). Traditionally disadvantaged subgroups such as rural dwellers,



scheduled castes and tribes, Muslims, and young children are still the poorest in 2015-16.
